## **CSU Long Angeles:**

- (1.1) Two courses (6 units) of diversity courses are required for graduation, at least one focusing on issues of race and ethnicity and intersectionality with other social categories that structure inequality in society. It is not an admission requirement and may be completed prior to or after transferring in. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> course, student can fulfill it by taking either GEOG G185, HIST G170, HIST G175, SOC G100, or SOC G110.
- (1.2) Students must include 6 units of a modern foreign language in their lower division program or offer proof of successful completion of three years of modern language study in high school, or receiving a score indicating at least 2nd year proficiency on the college level foreign language placement test as an acceptable equivalent

### **UC Berkeley:**

• (2.1) Completion of IGETC requirements (or L&S GE) by spring is required for fall enrollment

#### **UC Irvine:**

- (3.1) Required ANTH G100, plus 2 courses from either ANTH G130, ANTH G180, ANTH or G190
- (3.2) For the Social Science Math requirement, MATH G160/PSYC G140 and MATH G180, or a year-long statistics sequence after transfer (SOC SCI 10A + 10B + 10C) for the major. Students choosing to complete the year-long statistics sequence after transfer must still complete a qualifying transferable mathematics course for admission.

#### UCLA:

- (4.1) BS degree: also needs to take MATH G180 + G185, BIOL G180 + G182, CHEM G180 + G185, CHEM G220 and MATH G160

- (5.1) only ANTH G100 is a recommended major prep for Sociocultural Anthropology
- (5.2) only ANTH G 130 is a recommended major prep for Archaeology concentration.
- (5.3) only ANTH G185 is a recommended major prep for BA Biological Anthropology concentration.
- (5.4) Biological Anthropology BS: required ANTH G185, BIOL G180 + G186 or (G182 + G183), CHEM G180 + G185, MATH G180 + G185 (or G280), MATH G160, and PSYC G100
- (5.5) International Studies-Anthropology BA: require a foreign language and pre-requisite courses in Economic/International Business/Philosophy disciplinary focus.
