CSU DOMINGUEZ HILLS: BA Political Science.

1.1: Coursework in International Relations and Comparative Politics highly recommended (PSCI G110 + G185)

CSU FULLERTON: BA Political Science.

2.1: PSCI G180 is a graduation requirement for all students and is not required for the major, but is a prerequisite to further work in Political Science at this campus. Not more than 12 units total (PSCI G180 + 9 other units) may be lower division coursework.

CSU LONG BEACH: BA Political Science. Concentration requirements available in Law, Politics and Society; Global Politics; Political Theory; and General. All majors at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Local Admission: Minimum 2.5 GPA required and completion of major preparation coursework above for admission.

3.1: One additional lower division course in Political Science required for minimum admission requirements. PSCI G150 is a requirement for the Political Theory concentration.

UC BERKELEY: BA Political Science.

Government will satisfy POSC 15.

4.1: Students must complete IGETC for selection to this major. AP Credit cannot be used for this major.

4.2: Complete one History course from: HIST G150, G170, G175, G180, G185

UC IRVINE: BA Political Science. Major has two options for completing lower-division quantitative reasoning requirements. Complete one course in statistics (MATH G160 or PSYC G140) and one semester of Calculus (MATH G180) or complete a qualifying mathematics course for admission from the IGETC Area 2 list, and complete one year of social science statistics after transfer (SOC SCI 10A+10B+10C)

5.1. Complete four political science courses from PSCI G100, PSCI G110, PSCI G150, PSCI G180, PSCI G181 and PSCI G185, PLUS one additional course in Political Science (any course not used above, or PSCI G130) and one Social Sciences course from: ANTH G100, G130, G150, G185, ECON G110, G170, G175, GEOG G100, G180, G185, HIST G110, PSCI G110, G130, G185, PSY G100, G116, G118, G250, G255, SOC G100, G110, 133, G134, 185.

UCLA: Major is highly selective. Students should complete MATH G160, at least three of the other required Political Science courses. All courses must be taken for a letter grade. After transfer to UCLA, students may not change their major to Political Science if they were originally admitted to another major. AP exams in American Government, Comparative Government or Statistics cannot be used to meet major preparation.

UC RIVERSIDE: BA Political Science. Options available in Administrative Studies, International Affairs, and Public Service. Additional program in BA Public Policy available. Students are encouraged to complete IGETC prior to transfer. 6.1: AP Credit: A score of 3, 4, or 5 on the AP United States Government exam will satisfy POSC 10. A score of 3, 4, or 5 on the AP Comparative

UC SAN DIEGO: BA Political Science. Eight concentrations available: American Politics, Comparative Politics, Data Analytics, International Relations, Political Theory, Public Law, Public Policy, and Race/Ethnicity/Politics.

7.1: Additional lower-division Political Science courses must be taken at UCSD after transfer.
