Peer Tutoring

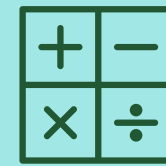
Individual tutoring is available for all levels of writing assistance. Students can make an appointment or drop in at their convenience.

Student Computer Center

The Academic Success Center houses the central Student Computer Center on campus with over 100 PC and MAC computers loaded with all the software used by our academic programs across campus. Laptop and desktop computers are available for students who need to attend a live online class or take an online exam with Respondus. Students are welcome to spend as much time as they need working on assignments, checking email, or just catching up on social media. Printing is available for a small fee.



Embedded Tutoring

The Embedded Tutoring Program places tutors in specific classes to help increase student learning, success, and retention. Embedded tutors work in and/or outside the classroom under the instructors' guidance to help students understand course concepts and enhance student engagement.

Instructors can request an embedded tutor for their individual classes or work together with their department to develop a comprehensive approach.



Directed Learning Activities

Directed Learning Activities (DLAs) are short activities that provide just-in-time remediation to help prepare students for their coursework. Students complete the activity independently and then meet with a tutor to review the material.
